

<p><b>I. Warm up</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Review vocabulary of fruits through word cards.</li> <li>* Choose seven fruit cards and put them in order as Monday to Sunday.</li> </ul>	5	slides
<p><b>II. Introduction (Presentation)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Read the book “The Very Hungry Caterpillar”.</li> <li>* Questions about the content.               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. What are the fruits that the caterpillar ate in a week?</li> <li>2. Which fruit is your favorite?</li> <li>3. What did the caterpillar turn into at the end of the story?</li> </ol> </li> </ul>	15	slides
<p><b>III. Activities (Practice/Production)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Worksheet : “ If I were the Very Hungry Caterpillar...”</li> <li>* Write down the seven fruits chosen on each day, and add the corresponding number.</li> <li>* Draw a butterfly.</li> </ul>	10	slides worksheet
<p><b>IV. Assessment (Production)</b></p> <p>Share what kind of fruits they chose on each day and show the butterfly to group members/ class.</p>	5	worksheet
